FEAST OF OUR LADY HELP OF CHRISTIANS

Yesterday every class at St Monica's had a special liturgy to celebrate the feast of Our Lady Help of Christians. In 1844, a significant time in our history, the Australian Catholic Church was placed under the patronage of Our Lady Help of Christians. British settlement was just over 50 years old, the transportation of convicts was coming to an end, and the first election had been held in 1843. The new country was also dealing with the issue of land, immigration and education. We continue to confront the same social problems in our country today. In 1901, the year of Federation, the traditional image of Our Lady Help of Christians was adapted to emphasise her links with Australia: the map of Australia was introduced at Our Lady's feet and the Southern Cross was placed in the sky behind her. Our Lady's right hand is open, reaching out to help her children. Lastly, the crown expresses the significance of Mary as Queen of Heaven.


