Please go to www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au and click on the blue square with the gold star "Start Here" and then follow the prompts. This check is free for volunteers and is valid for <u>5 years</u>.

Please ensure that both of these are completed <u>BEFORE</u> you volunteer. Parents who have not completed these checks are not eligible to assist in the classroom or on excursions.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO REMOVE A STUDENT FROM ST MONICA'S PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Catholic Education, Diocese of Parramatta, has developed a policy relating to the notice required from parents to terminate their child/children's enrolment in the schools of the Parramatta Diocese. In part this policy states that "A term's notice (10 weeks) in writing must be given to the principal before the removal of a student or a full term's fees will be paid. The notice can be given anytime during the term for the next term." This means that unless the school receives a term's notice then no pro rata adjustment will be given for part term tuition.

Notice in writing will be accepted at anytime during Term 4 in relation to the following year's enrolment. In this circumstance the requirement for 10 week's notice will be waived.

Commonwealth Bank School Banking Update - Please Read

Following the decision last month to **recall** the **Cosmic Light Beam Torch** due to a potential safety issue, a decision has been made to also withdraw the upcoming Lunar Light Band reward from the School Banking Rewards Program. Parents are reminded that **anaphylaxis** is a serious and rapid allergic reaction usually involving more than one part of the body. St Monica's currently has students who can suffer severe allergic reactions (**life-threatening**) through contact with food containing nuts. As we endeavour to provide for the different needs of all our students your co-operation is invited to assist the school in supporting and catering for the needs of these particular students, and any future students, by providing your child only with **foods that are <u>nut free</u>**. Please note that the school has not banned any other products. Thank you for your co-operation.

Many children appear to be eating all of the food provided at recess and therefore do not have having anything to eat at lunchtime.
