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On Monday, at the Staff Development Day, our focus was on our mathematics goal. It was a very productive day where staff focused on their teaching practice, examined work samples and also had a closer look at our numeracy NAPLAN results. Thank you to all the staff who contributed to the success of the day.

Today we welcomed Senior Constable Dusan Dakic, School Liaison Police, to talk to our Stage 2 and Stage 3 students about cybersafety.

Some of the important points that Constable Dakic stressed with our students included:

- **Passwords**—'Yours and yours alone", ensure it is a strong password. Parents should know their children's passwords and usernames.
- Parents must be aware of their child's online activity, especially if they are using sites where they are underage;
- The importance of only being 'friends' and communicating with people that they actually know.
- Telling an adult if cyberbullying is happening to them or someone that they know.
- Think before you post.

During the holidays a number of projects were completed in the school. The air conditioners were all serviced, the carpets were cleaned and Mr Dennis started improvements in the garden near the hall.

A major painting project will commence at the school during this term. Parents may have noticed that we have a number of damaged walls and a lot of the paint is now peeling. The notice can be given any time during the term for the next term." This means that unless the school receives a term's notice no pro rata adjustment will be given for part term tuition.
