St Monica's Primary School is now accepting enrolments for Kindergarten (Early Stage One). When lodging your application you will need to provide your child's **original birth and baptismal certificates and an up-to-date immunisation form.** A \$30 non-refundable Enrolment Application Fee will need to be returned with your completed application.

When lodging your Enrolment form you will be given an interview time - your child will need to attend this meeting with you. **Enrolment interviews will take place during Term 2.** 

The closing date for Kindergarten 2015 enrolments is Friday 11 April 2014 (last day of Term 1)


