Dear Parents and Carers,

Home Learning

Thank you to those parents who dropped off workbooks and worksheets for teachers to provide feedback to students. If your child is uploading work to Google Classroom and is accessing work online, there is no need to come and collect "Home Learning Packs" as this is all available online and teachers are providing feedback online.

In order to keep everyone safe, including our staff at St Monica's, and to comply with the governments' instructions of social distancing and of only leaving home for essential business, we are attempting to reduce the need for parents to come and collect items from school. All online work is available via Google Classroom (K-6), however, if you are having difficulty accessing and posting work online, you will still

be able to collect "Home Learning Packs" (K-1) next week. More information to come via Skoolbag.



Attendance

Teachers have been monitoring student learning and we will mark the roll according to the following:

In all circumstances where a student is willing to attend school but prevented by adverse circumstances and/or Government directive, and as explained by their parent, they should be absent using the F code.

Students who are required to self-isolate for the various reasons provided by the government - F code.

- Students who were quarantined overseas and couldn't return to NSW, or who have returned but have been directed to self-isolate **F code**.
- Students whose parents are following the Premier's advice and are at home engaged in learning – F code.

The following codes are to be used under the following circumstances:

A Code (Absence unexplained or unjustified)

There is no evidence of students completing work, therefore students are on unapproved leave. Diocesan offices and RI and PJP schools need to manage how they determine whether a student being kept at home is engaging in their learning.

S Code (Absence due to sickness)

Parents advise the school that their child is sick and not able to attend school and therefore unable to complete work.

L Code (Absence due to leave)

Parent has provided an explanation for the absence which has been accepted by the principal and student is unable to complete work.

If you are yet to provide us with an explanation for your child/ren's absence from school, please do so as soon as possible


School Photos


